APRIL 3, 2017**

Mayor Cargill called a regular meeting of the Marlette City Council to order at 7:00 p.m. and led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Wilson, Babich, Moshier, Hunter. Excused: Quade and Bush. Also Present: City Manager Corey Schmidt.

**Motion by Babich and second by Moshier to approve minutes of March 6, 2017 as presented.**

**Motion by Hunter and second by Babich to approve payment of Accounts Payable dated March 9, 2017 as presented in the amount of \$53,758.25.**

**MANAGER REPORT:** Manager Schmidt reported: 1. The Recreation Passport Grant was submitted to the State of Michigan. He noted that there were several letters of support for the project from Marlette Schools, Marlette Regional Hospital, Grupo Antolin, and the Marlette Township Board.  
2. Corey attended the second part of the Redevelopment Ready Communities training. A self-evaluation will be completed and a resolution will be presented at the May Council meeting.

**POLICE CHIEF REPORT:** Chief McGinnis reported: 1. The Dodge police car is still being worked on.  
2. Thirteen people attended the Narcan training today at City Hall and another is scheduled in June.

Manager Schmidt recommended awarding the cemetery mowing bid to the low bidder – Victor's Service. He spoke to his references and the low bid would be a saving.

**B. WWTP UV Bulbs and Sleeves Purchase**

Jared from the WWTP reported that the plant is due for an upgrade/replacement of UV Violet disinfection system and currently have no UV bulbs which eventually would be a violation of the permit limits.

**Motion by Hunter and second by Moshier to approve the purchase of UV bulbs, sleeves, and associated hardware at a total cost of \$6,093.26.**

**C. Resolution #03-2017 – Safe Routes to School Grant Program**

Manager Schmidt reported that the resolution would authorize the City Manager to apply for funding through the Safe Routes to School program administered by MDOT.

**Motion by Babich and second by Wilson to pass the resolution to authorize the grant application.**

Discussion was held on the number of trees that will be removed with the project. Mayor Cargill expressed concern about removing many of trees on Wilson Street. Manager Schmidt noted that a number of the trees do conflict with the sidewalks, but that the cost estimate assumes the worst. He said they would try to save as many as possible if awarded the grant. Discussion followed.
