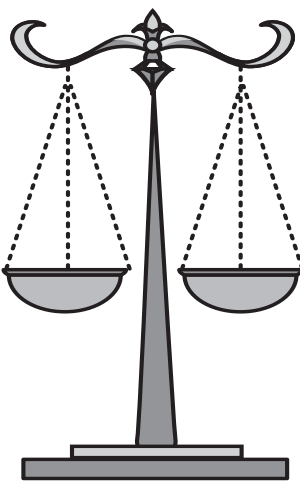

to tend to their duties. The committee sent the request to the full board for approval, with O'Mara supporting the motion. O'Mara also asked the county administrator to provide more detailed budget information when bills are presented to the board for approval. New District 5 Commissioner, Joel Wyatt, challenged the tendency of the finance and administration committee, which is a committee of the whole board of commissioners, to approve department spending requests at the committee level, instead of sending the requests

to the board for action, which can take an additional two weeks. While some items might require immediate action, Wyatt questioned if there is too much "hurry up" to approve items that need the additional time for review. The item that prompted Wyatt's comments was a request by Friend of the Court for an independent security audit. After making his concerns known, Wyatt joined the rest of the committee in giving immediate approval, since delaying the audit could jeopardize 66 percent state funding for the department.
