These special show dates are to be held outdoors on West Morris Street, alongside the Farmers Market in the heart of downtown Marlette, and will be held rain or shine. All fees go to support our Farmers Market. Since it is outdoors, masks are optional at the time of this application but may be required if directed by the state at the time of the event. We do ask that you have hand sanitizer available, and limit the touching of items by customers until they are ready to buy. Whenever possible, sanitize items after a customer touches them before putting them back on display. We will provide signage across the venue asking people not to touch. Booths will be spaced at least 6 feet apart, and we expect you to maintain social distancing.

YOU MUST PREPAY TO RESERVE A SPACE, but your fees will be refunded if the event cannot happen due to COVID restrictions or a stay home order by the Governor.
